 - a. Teacher’s Report
 - i. Kindergarten; students are learning about 3D shapes and noticing how they appear in the world around them. They are connecting literacy and SEL through the story ‘Robots First Snowfall’
 - ii. Grade 1; is starting a new social studies unit with a focus on language and vocabulary around mountains prairies, rives, lakes and forests.
 - iii. Grade 2; are learning about Canada’s regions through art (including arctic art). They are learning about triple scoop words to add interest to their writing
 - iv. Grade 3; are learning about simple machines in science including levers, rollers and wheels. They are also learning about the Metis and francophone people as part of Alberta’s past
 - v. Grade 4; Just went on a field trip to Heritage Park to learn about Alberta’s history and our natural resources
 - vi. Grade 5; working on developing division strategies including the “Big 7”. They are working on persuasive writing.
 - vii. EES; Have been building functional living skills to support independence including preparing food
 - viii. Music; Students are completing a March Madness bracket to focus on critical literacy
